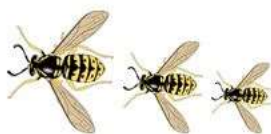

## Further adjustments to our morning drop-off arrangements from tomorrow, Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2020

### Dear Parents and Carers,

As the weather is forecast to start to change soon, it is necessary for us to adapt our morning drop-off arrangements again. At the moment, arrangements for Reception, Y1, Y2, Y5 and Y6 will remain the same as today.

**Please note that collection arrangements will stay the same as now, for everyone.**

**The following changes will apply to Y3 and Y4 tomorrow, Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2020.**

**Year 3:** Please enter through the car gate (as now) and continue to go along the bark path at the top of the field. At the top of the main drive, parents can say goodbye to children and leave via the gate there (same exit gate as now). Children will be met by staff to walk them around the path at the back of Middle WASPS to where their teachers will be waiting for them, to enter their classrooms via the outside doors. If parents do need to accompany their children to the rear playground, please follow the one-way system which will bring you back up the tarmac drive behind the kitchen back to the main gate to exit.

**Year 4:** Please enter through the same gate as today, go along the top of the field and bring your children down the drive, all as before. Please leave your children at the bottom of the drive and return up the drive. Children will then walk in front of the office, up the slope and into the door to the link, turning left and passing the swimming pool on their right. They will enter their classrooms through the external doors there.

Obviously, there is a potential for congestion by the main gate where you all exit. We are hoping that with the 8.45 - 9.15 slot (as now), this will not be a problem.
